This vintage-inspired master bathroom was created for a family rebuilding their home in the Virginia-Highland area. Interior Designer Jenny Warner used nods to the original materials of the home—a key to the success of the design. "Elements like the clawfoot tub, plumbing fixtures, and detailed casement windows with mullions all give a traditional feel that the neighborhood is known for." She explains that the long space in the room "begged to have some type of pattern in the floor. I'm really proud of how it turned out and the way it draws the space together and shows off that tub!" She says that the hexagon-shaped marble tiles that she chose for the shower floor is a style that would have been used in that neighborhood originally around 1918. She says of the installation process, "It took some drawings and onsite direction to get the precise layout that worked best for the space. That poor tile guy putting up with my exacting demands for this floor was totally worth it!"
